We believe in sustainability, both in our relationships and in our products. Baron Francois partners with some of the oldest multigenerational wineries and distilleries in France and around the globe. As such, we value the techniques they have been practicing in harmony with nature for centuries. SUMMARY

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Certifications

CERTIFIED VEGAN

Wine or estate that is not using any animal by product in their process: either in the fining or filtering of the wine (so no egg white or gelatin for example).

CERTIFIED SUSTAINABLE

Sustainable wine estates are focused on minimizing the effect their winemaking process has on the environment. They prioritize conservation, preservation, social responsibility and economic feasibility. It's about finding a balance between production and preservation.

Being a guardian of both natural and human resources allows for a myriad of sustainability certifications. The most famous French certification being **HEV** "High environmental value" and **Terra Vitis**.

HEV corresponds to the highest level of a more general scheme of environmental certification for farms. The certification covers four key areas: biodiversity conservation, plant protection strategy, management of fertiliser use and management of water.

CERTIFIED ORGANIC

To label wines as organically grown or certified organic, a winery must fulfill all the requirements stated by its home country's governing body of agriculture, for instance the US Dept. of Agriculture (**USDA**) or **ECOCERT** in Europe.

The grapes are grown without the use of chemical fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, or fungicides.

CERTIFIED BIODYNAMIC

Biodynamic farming arose from a growing concern around soil fertility and sees the vineyard as a self-sustaining, living organism in which measures of prevention, rather than treatment, can be taken to create harmonious conditions. Biodynamic growing allows the land's natural biodiversity to grow without intervention to provide a fully functioning and inherently resilient ecosystem.

In addition to organic and sustainable practices, biodynamics considers external forces such as gravity, light, planetary cycles, and the moon as well as the sun. The estate uses Biodynamic vine growing practices that have been certified by **Demeter** or **Biodyvin**.

Founded in 1825, **Joseph Perrier** has been owned and run by the same family since 1888, Benjamin Fourmon, the current Managing Director, represents the 6th generation, who is still searching for excellence. Less than 100 years after its creation, the Joseph Perrier champagnes were being drunk at the Royal Court in England. Today Joseph Perrier is the only house still making champagne in Châlons-en-Champagne.

The house owns three kilometres of wonderful galleries whose origins date back to the Gallo-Roman period. Several million bottles age here in conditions of total quiet and stability for a minimum of three years. Joseph Perrier also owns beautifully situated vineyards of 21 hectares, located in the heart of champagne on the right bank of the river Marne, around Hautvillers and Cumières, two villages ranked 93% in the « échelle des crus, » mostly planted with Pinot Noir but also including 2 hectares of Chardonnay.

Though the estate originated in the 13th century, the actual castle dates back to the end of the 15th century. Even Balzac used to own it, and in his novel "La femme de trente ans," he immortalized Moncontour and its wines. The total surface of the vineyards is composed of 346 acres spread out over several types of soils of Vouvray and Touraine appellations near Tours.
