Pure Emotion has a light pink silvery color and subtle aromas of wild strawberry associated with a straight and elegant richness.

This really very pure wine will be perfect for the aperitif or associated with scallops.

Goes with: Aperitifs and scallops

Served chilled between 45°F - 47 °F / 7 - 8 °C

**Maison Antech** For six generations already, we are an independent family business specialized in the elaboration of sparkling wines. Yearly we produce 950.000 bottles of Crémant, Blanquette de Limoux and Blanquette Méthode Ancestrale. Our winery, where tradition and modernity are going hand in hand, is located in Limoux, at the Domaine de Flassian. Our wines are the expression of a delicate blend of our land, our grape varieties Chardonnay, Chenin and Mauzac, and our traditional values.

We believe in an authentic and direct winemaking, with respect for our environment. That's why all our grapes come from vineyards conducted in agriculture durable.

**Vinification** All grapes are hand picked, carried to the fermenting room in cases of at most 300 kilograms, and then immediately pressed pneumatically. The juices selected are then fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel vats set at low temperatures. Effervescence then occurs naturally over a period around 12 months according to the traditional method, in temperature controlled cellars.

**Terroir** Hillsides and terraces gentle sloping clay-limestone soil Mediterranean climate with an oceanic influence Vine age: 20 to 40 years on average
