Château Billerond is a 16 hectares property towards the Eastern part of the village of Saint Emilion. Characterised by its fresh fruit character with medium-bodied style.

Soils : clayey with sandy parts with iron oxide in the subsoil

Area under vine : 16.22 hectares

Varieties : 75% Merlot, 25% Cabernets

Average age of the vines : 25 - 30 years

Winemaking :

100% fermented in stainless steel after a pre ferment maceration of one week. Pressed vertically for a very soft extraction.

Tasting notes:

This has lovely, soft Merlot fruit with ripe tannins and red berry fruit flavours on the palate. Slight hints of oak are coming through.

Serving:

At room temperature. This wine can be enjoyed with easy going food. Even better as an aperitif.
