Tasting notes

Planted in 1903 on the beautifull terroir of Brochon Coteaux. Excellent red and black fruit that is beautifully underlined by the full, healthy tannins on the medium-to fullbodied palate. Savory, nutty and earthy. This has plenty of cherries. Rather elegant, moderately dry tannins, which give this a graceful line. It drinks very well now but can be wait way longer.
