THE ESTATE

Château Haut Selve has become the only wine-growing creation of the 20th century in Bordeaux, on a historic terroir of the Graves destroyed by phylloxera and left in a forest state for 120 years. The estate is committed to excellence and sustainability. Its motto, "Non Nova Sed Nové", not new things but in a different way, illustrates a desire for constant questioning.

Since 2018, the estate has been certified HVE3 and TerraVitis.

THE VINEYARD

- **Parcel selection:** 1 hectare (2.47 acres)
- **Soil:** Sandy-gravelly on deep gravel
- **Planting density:** 5,500 vines per hectare (2,226 vines per acre)
- **Pruning:** Adapted to the vigor of each vine
- **Leaf area:** Greater than 13,000 m² per hectare (139,930 square feet per acre)
- **Soil nutrition:** Green manure (fava beans, peas, mustard)
- **Soil cultivation:** Mechanical inter-row cultivation, no herbicides **Suckering** Manual and mechanical only, no chemical inputs **Bud thinning:** In May t adjust the number of bunches per vine **Yield:** 37 hectoliters per hectare (24. gallons per acre)

Hand-harvested

- Vatting of whole bunches with 35% stems
- Maceration and fermentation in temperature-controlled in stainless-steel tanks
- Extraction controlled by analysis of the marc cap
- Aged for 8 months in 750-liter Tava amphorae
- Blend: 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon
- No added sulfites
