The PINOT NOIR, grandfather of Syrah and father of Chardonnay, deserved in our eyes Respect, Humility and Time too.

The PINOT NOIR, also called petit doré in Aÿ, so much the golden points stuck on its bloom shine at harvest time, is of such complexity, freshness, elegance, that it has become the grail that every great wine would like to reach.

A wine, which will draw so far back to its origins in a bed of stratified coccoliths there 90 million years ago, deserves respect. Let's pay tribute to him for the aura he has hung on to Champagne in just four centuries.
