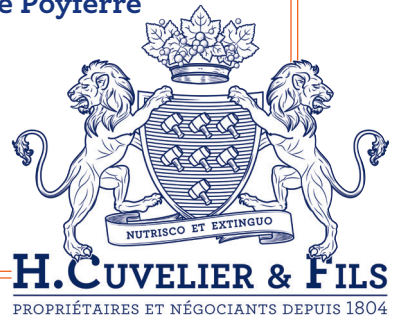

Second wine of Châteaux Léoville Poyferré, 2nd GCC and Moulin Riche



Pavillon de Léoville Poyferré is the second wine of Chateau Léoville Poyferré and Château Moulin Riche.

This wine is produced mainly from the estate's younger vines. The same winemaking philosophy surrounds its production as its two older brothers, Château Léoville Poyferré and Château Moulin Riche.



Technical sheet

📍 Area

80 hectares.

🌱 Soil

Garonne gravel and aeolian sands.

📅 **Average vineyard age**
15-20 years old.

🍇 Harvest

Manual into small crates with a sorting of the grapes in the vineyard and optical sorting after destemming.

🍷 Vinification

In stainless steel vats.

🕒 Ageing

In oak barrels of 2 wines for 12 months. Fining with egg whites.

🍷 Blend

63 % Cabernet Sauvignon
24 % Merlot
3 % Cabernet Franc
10 % Petit Verdot

«Dark color, intense and purple. Intense bouquet, fine, with ripe fruity taste. Subtle. Smooth palate, developing caressing, very perfumed and especially living between the middle and the finish. Fine tannins. Wonderful! 2017 – 2030.»
