The Estate:

Created in the 1930's, the family estate has been passed down through five generations. They considered the soils were perfectly adapted to vines and decided to start planting to produce grapes and wines of the highest quality. The family extended it to over 24 hectares of vines planted with Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noir.

Varietal:

100% Pinot Noir.

Soil

Limestone.

Tasting notes:

Black cherry, licorice, leather, mushroom, forest floor and earth on the nose. This (Burgundian style) Loire Valley Pinot Noir is also lifted by a whiff of cranberry and wild strawberry. Lush and fine-grained; the musky red currant and spice flavors are supported by perfectly integrated ripe acidity. Finishes with an enticing return of fruit and a good acidic lift. The finish shows that you can drink this wine now, or it will also keep a few years. Great pairing with veal, deer and poultry.
